

Durnan Property Maintenance Winter Practices 2010-11

In order to clear up any confusion as to how and when we clear snow, the following are the guidelines that we use when determining whether we will clear snow that has fallen.

- If there is an accumulation of 1½ inches or more.
- Whether there is any drifting.
- If any further snow fall is expected.
- The expected temperature.

If the snow fall is during the daytime we will try to wait until the snow has finished and clear it all up in one go, this will often result in us clearing the snow the following day. However, if you need the snow cleared earlier please give us a phone call and we will get to you as soon as we can, we usually have trucks on the road most days.

If you have an appointment early during the day, please call the evening before and we will ensure that your driveway is clear for you to go out. Your driveway will be cleared early in the morning, but only quickly so that you can get out, then we will clean it up when we come back round, as we would normally.

ICE

If you have a build up of ice on your driveway or should we have an ice storm we have a supply of sand/salt mixture which we can use for your paths and driveways, if you require any please call. Because the salt component of the mix can be harmful to some stone work and grass we will not put any down unless you call first. Our mixture has a low percentage of salt in it, but without it the sand will not break up the ice.
